## FCPRD Re-Opening Plan for the Summer 2020

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Parks and Recreation cancelled programs and closed recreation facilities based on recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Virginia Department of Health (VDH), Virginia Department of Social Services (VOSS), and the Governor's Stay at Home Guidelines. Recently, the Governor of Virginia initiated Safer at Home with Phase 2 general parameters.

Below you will find an outline of the Parks and Recreation Department's plan to open recreation facilities and programs in Phase 2. We understand compliance is needed with future guidelines from the CDC, VDH, VDSS, and specifics of the Governor's Safer at Home Guidelines.

### **In response to Phase 2 of the Virginia COVID-19 Reopening Plan:**

#### **(Phase 2 begins Friday, June 5)**

##### **basicREC Summer Camp - Program opens Monday, June 15**

Camp locations will be Evendale, Gainesboro, and Greenwood Mill – Online registration will open to Frederick County residents on Tuesday, June 9 at 12:01 am. Online registration will open to non-residents on Thursday, June 11 at 12:01 am. If it is necessary to come into the office, call ahead to schedule an in-person meeting, so staff can be prepared to meet with you.

##### **Trails, Disc Golf, Bike Park, Open Space – Open**

Social Distancing as in Phase 1

##### **Shelters – Open Saturday, June 13 – Registration opens Monday, June 8.**

Capacity is 50 people or 50% of normal capacity per shelter, whichever is fewer. No outside vendors permitted at this time.

##### **Soccer Fields – Open Monday, June 8**

Capacity 50 people per field. Rentals for practices only. Fields will not be lined until Phase 3 or later.

##### **Baseball/Softball Fields – Open Monday, June 8**

Capacity 50 people per field. Rentals for practices only · No lines. Batting cage open at Field 8

#### **Sand Volleyball Courts – Open Friday, June 5**

Capacity 50 people for the entire Clearbrook complex. (includes all three courts) Rentals for practices only.

#### **Playgrounds – Open Friday, June 5**

Capacity no more than 50 people in the playground area. Per CDC guidelines- Normal cleaning- No disinfection

#### **Outdoor Exercise Equipment**

Awaiting guidelines for use.

#### **Pools – Open June 15**

No general swim or group rentals. Check our website for program information in the near future.

#### **July 4 Fireworks at Sherando Park - Cancelled**

**Summer Programming/Camps – Registration will open on Monday, June 15 for July programs.**

**Private Gym Rentals/Indoor Fitness Rooms/ Racquetball**

**Indoor Recreation Programs and Trips will not be held in Phase 2**

### **Registering for a Program with Frederick County Parks and Recreation**

It is highly encouraged that everyone uses our online registration system or contacts us via the phone at 540-665-5678. Hours of operation are Monday – Friday from 8 am-5 pm. We are asking those who must come in physically to park in the parking lot on Cameron Street and enter through the double doors which will be unlocked from 8am-5pm. There will be a deputy on duty to guide people through the building to help maintain safe social distancing. Visitors will see signage posted about keeping social distancing, and they should follow tape marks on the floor to help maintain the recommended 6 feet distance. Some people may be required to wait outside depending on the number of people waiting.

When it is necessary or required to come into the office, call ahead to schedule an in-person meeting, so staff can be prepared to meet with you. With new CDC guidelines in place, we have been forward thinking about how we notify the public.

As we transition into our new registration procedure, patrons may experience the following during a visit; wearing a face covering, maintaining social distancing of 6 feet, barriers between staff and patrons, and limited access to office building.
